

Day 1 Arrive in Frankfurt and start your journey, with a drive via Stuttgart to the edge of the Black Forest

You arrive in Frankfurt today by your own arrangements. Your car will be waiting for you. After we hand over the car to you, you will set out on your first drive south toward Stuttgart, home to several of Germany's major car manufacturers, including Porsche and Mercedes Benz.

You will arrive in Stuttgart in time for lunch in one of the city's finest restaurants. For guests interested in the region's motoring history, it will be possible to visit one of Stuttgart's motoring museums in the afternoon.

From Stuttgart, you will drive to Baden-Baden, one of Germany's best-known spa towns.

Your hotel for the night is Baden-Baden's grandest. Dinner will be at your hotel.

Day 2 Drive through the Black Forest on your way to the Swiss Alps...

Today you will get a glimpse of Germany's Black Forest, which lies in the country's south-west, abutting France and Switzerland. It is a region of rolling hills, still largely covered with ancient forests. In contrast to the rocky austerity of the Swiss Alps (which you

will see the following day), the landscape of the Black Forest is charming and inviting.

Depending on your appetite for driving, we will choose more or fewer of the beautiful back roads that crisscross the Black Forest region.

In the late afternoon you will arrive in the wealthy enclave of Gstaad in the heart of the Swiss Alps. You will stay here for two nights.



Day 3
Discover the best of Gstaad - glaciers, horse-drawn carriages and fresh mountain air

Today you can make a late start. Before noon, you will have a short drive from your hotel to a small village called Lauenen. There you will exchange your 400 horse powers for 2: you will continue today's program with a horse-drawn carriage ride that will take you to a beautiful, turquoise lake at the very end of a narrow valley

where you will enjoy lunch in a rustic restaurant right above the lake. The landscape and feeling of being in the middle of nowhere will be superb! After lunch, you will switch back to your car and drive for an hour to Les Diablerets for a cable car ride to a 3000m high lookout from where you will have exceptional views across the Alps... best of all,

this lookout is relatively little known, all the better for you to enjoy a special moment up there at three thousand meters altitude.

Day 4
Via Lac Leman and
Aix-Les-Bains to
France's foodie
capital, Lyon...

"Morgenstund hat Gold im Mund" we say in German.
Roughly, it means: "Treasures await those who are willing to rise early." Today, you'll need to bear this in mind. The morning's drive will combine an exciting Swiss mountain pass, a Swiss highway that skirts, around beautiful Lake

Geneva, and then French country roads that will give you a first taste of things to come. Lunch will be at a very special place overlooking the ultramarine waters of Lac du Bourget near Aix-les-Bains.

After a leisurely lunch, it is just a 90-minute drive to your hotel



After a few days of driving, today you will leave your car parked.

We have planned a set of leisurely excursions to discover Lyon, which has been a major French town since the Roman times. (Then it was called Lugdunum). Lyon does not only have a fascinating cultural

and architectural history, but is also the centre of the development of French cuisine.

We have created a tour that will give you a taste of both Lyon's history and culinary traditions while still leaving free time for you to explore the city.

If the weather is fine, another option would be to take the longer drive across the Col de Rousset. This second option will require an earlier start, and an adventurous drive through the French countryside.

Whichever option you choose, the group will meet for lunch in Grignan.

After a slow meal enjoying the environment of your Michelinstarred restaurant, you will continue for the short drive to your destination, Joucas, in the heart of Provence's Luberon region.

Dinner will be at your hotel.

Today you're off to the Côte d'Azur! In order to allow you to enjoy driving largely on country roads, you will have to make a relatively early start. At first, you continue through the Luberon – lavender and more lavender as far as your eyes can see. At a small mountain village, which counts as one of France's most beautiful, we will stop for lunch to recharge in, we dare say, the most beautiful restaurant of the journey...

After a leisurely lunch and perhaps a stroll through the garden, you will continue south-east on country roads along lakes and through tiny

villages, across gentle hills and into broad valleys.

In the late afternoon, you will arrive in Saint Paul de Vence, high above the Côte d'Azur.

Day 9
A day of sight-seeing and a short drive to conclude your journey...


On the penultimate day of your journey, you may wish to spend the day exploring on your own, or relaxing at your hotel.


